Role; Registered Nurse Location: All Hallows, Bungay Shifts/Weekly Hours: Full time or Part time

Key Objectives

- To take responsibility for the nursing provision within the establishment.
- To provide a high standard of direct nursing to residents based on the assessment of care needs and in consultation with the residents, their relatives, other health professionals and the care team.
